JUDGES INVITATION

The Mexican chapter of the Latin American Council of Comparative and International Law Scholars (known in Spanish as **COLADIC-MEXICO**) have the pleasure to invite those interested in participating as judges in the 7th Edition of the International Moot Court Competition “**V́ctor Carlos Garcia Moreno, Proceedings before the International Criminal Court**” (known in Spanish as VCGM), which will be held **in Mexico City from August 18th to the 22nd** .

This competition is one of a kind. It not only promotes Public International Law, Human Rights and Humanitarian Law, but it primarily focuses on the functioning of the International Criminal Court. Up to date, this competition has counted with the participation of law schools from all around the globe, such as Argentina, Costa Rica, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, Guatemala, Panama, Spain, Venezuela and Mexico.

The competition will be carried out in two stages: **a)** the written stage, which consists of the preparation of two written memorials, one from the Prosecutor’s perspective and the other from the State’s perspective, and **b)** the oral stage, in which the teams shall defend both postures before a panel of judges.

The official languages are English and Spanish.

For all those interested in participating as Judges both in the oral and/or written stages must meet the following requirements:

- I. A law or international relations degree;
- II. Knowledge of public international law and international criminal law;
- III. Not being Advisor or Coach of any participating Team;
- IV. Familiarity with international law competitions;
